1. SUBJECT : Improvement of cabin ventilating system.

2. AIRCRAFT AFFECTED: All FA-200 Series Serial Nos. 1 thru 101.

3. PRIORITY : Desirable.

4. REASON : In order to take cool air into canopy by installing

air scoop and four air outlet at upper surface of

canopy door.

5. DESCRIPTION : Air-outlet at upper surface of canopy door.

## 13. DETAILED INSTRUCTION:


- a. Remove the canopy door from airframe in accordance with service manual para. 7-4-11.
- b. Remove front rubber seal and stopper.
- c. Remove the cover, 200-534105-003 and -005, with twenty screws and eight rivets.
- d. Remove the left hand and right hand front canopy door cover, 200-534105-007 and -008, with fourteen screws.
- e. Remove left hand and right hand wall assy, 200-534100-029 and -030.
- f. Remove the branket, 200-534102-053, -055 and -057.
- g. Remove the cable assy, 200-420125-015 and -017, in canopy lock system as shown in Fig. 10. in accordance with following procedures.
  - (a) Remove the inside handle (1) with its screw.
  - (b) Remove the inside cover (2) by loosing six screws.
  - (c) Pull out the handle toward upper direction (until halfway) by loosing two screws.

- (d) Move the Link Assy ((3) and (4)) downwards.
- (e) Separate Cable Assy (8) and link (9) by removing the pin (4).
- (f) Cut the safety-wire for the barrel (6) and then separate the pin (7) and cable assy.
- (g) Remove three clamps.
- h. Remove the frame outer skin at back surface of cover as above-mentioned para. 4 after cutting away some rivets except five rivets in center position of top.
- i. Remove the Air-inlet door assy, 200-420211-003, with four rivets which fixed hinge.
- j. Rework the C zone in Fig. 1 with same procedure as shown in Fig. 8.


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- (a) Remove old doubler with some rivets.
- (b) Install new doubler, 200-420211-021 and -022 to the same place which original doubler installed.
- (c) Patch the opening with patch plate, 200-420211-023.
- (d) Cut away door slide bracket, 200-420211-017 and -018, with same manner as shown in Fig. 7.
- k. Cut away outer skin at C zone in Fig. 1. in accordance with the manner as shown in Fig. 3.
- 1. Install the guide, 200-534320-003 and -004, and Scoop Assy, 200-534323-001, for c zone in Fig. 1. For these installation refer to Fig. 2. and Fig. 7.
- m. Cut away stiffener in E and F zone in Fig. 1. For the cutting details, refer to Fig. 5. and Fig. 4. Install the doubler, 200-420005-063 and -064 at opening place as shown in Fig. 4. Remove the doubler, 200-420005-031 and -032 with fifteen rivets.
- n. Install the Bracket Assy, 200-534321-003 and -004, and guide, 200-534320-005 and -006 at D zone in Fig. 1. For these installation, refer to Fig. 6.
- o. Install the Bracket Assy, 200-534322-003 and -004, at G zone in Fig. 1. For installation, refer to Fig. 6.


- p. Install the cable assy-lock mechanism-removed in step 7 with bracket in step 14 at reversed order of removal procedure.
  - q. Install four air valve assys (2215) to bracket assy as shown in step 14 and step 15 with sixteen screws, MS24694-50.
  - r. Install frame outer skin removed in step 8.
  - s. Cut away new branket, 200-534102-053, -055 and -057 as shown in Fig. 12 and adhere with adhesive cemedine #540.
  - t. Install two ducts, 200-550071-011, to bracket assy in the procedure shown in Fig. 6 with four clamps, 200-550076-003.
- u. Cut away the cover, 200-534105-003 and -005 as shown in Fig. 13 and install the cover the reversed order of removal procedure after attaching four seal rubbers, F-0486-00138.
- v. Install the front left hand and right hand cover, 200-534105-007 and -008 the reversed order of removal procedure.
- w. Install new front seal rubber stopper.
- x. Touch up the reconstructed position as for painting.
- y. Adhere the reconstructed left hand and right hand cover assys, 200-534100-061 and -062 with adhesive cemedine #508.
- z. Install the canopy door to the airframe in accordance with Service Manual para. 7-4-2.




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
