- SUBJECT
- : Prevention of possible interference between the lower portion of the front seat backs and structure (fuselage carry thru).
- AIRCRAFT AFFECTED: FA-200 Series, Serial Nos. 1 thru 134. 2.
- 3. PRIORITY

: Desirable.

- 4. REASON
- : To prevent possible interference between the lower portion of the front seat backs _and structure by changing the seat rail rear stoppers.
- 5. DESCRIPTION
- : To install new stoppers on the seat rail using the existing holes.
- ACCOMPLISHMENT
- : Optional.
- 7. APPROVAL
- : Not applicable.
- PARTS REQUIRED
- : The following parts are required to perform the modification:

- : None required.

10. WEIGHT AND BALANCE: Negligible.

11. REFERENCE : Not applicable.

12. MANHOUR REQUIRED : 0.5 manhour required.

13. DETAILED INSTRUCTIONS:

- (1) Remove the front seats in accordance with Service Manual, para. 7-7-1.
- (2) Remove the parts (listed below) composing the rear stoppers from the pilot seat left rail and co-pilot seat right rail: two screws, NAS220-20, four washers, AN960D8, four spacers, NAS43DD3-22, and two nuts, NAS679AO8W.
- (3) Install new stopper, 200-534205-9, in the same position, and secure with one screw, MS27039-0812, one nut, NAS679A08W, and three washers, AN960D8. (Removed hardware may be reused.) Tighten nut, but not too tight to cause stopper deformation.
- (4) Install the seats in the reversed order of removal, and check for smooth movement.
