## < Production >

While sales kept strong momentum led by continued high demand in North America, production decreased year-on-year for the following reasons:

- Domestic production decreased due to fewer working days. (one day less than October 2014)

- Overseas production decreased as a result of less overtime. (Production volume was particularly high in October 2014 with increased overtime.)

## < Japan Sales >

#### < Production >
