#### 1. Qualitative information on interim financial results

## (1) Explanation about operating performance

Revenue for the six months ended September 30, 2024 increased by 52.7 billion yen (2.4%) year on year to 2,266.2 billion yen due to profit contribution from foreign exchange fluctuation and price revision, despite rise in sales incentives and decreased unit sales. Operating profit increased by 36.2 billion yen (19.5%) to 222.0 billion yen and profit before tax decreased by 5.5 billion yen (2.4%) to 221.0 billion yen on a year on year basis due to the above factors. Profit for the period attributable to owners of parent increased by 12.1 billion yen (8.0%) year on year to 163.0 billion yen.

#### (i) Automobile Division

Domestic production for the six months ended September 30, 2024 decreased by 23,000 units (7.1%) year on year to 298,000 units. Overseas production came to 177,000 units, increasing by 4,000 units (2.5%) year on year. This resulted in a decrease in combined domestic and overseas production by 18,000 units (3.7%) year on year to 475,000 units.

Domestic unit sales increased by 5,000 units (10.6%) year on year to 50,000 units. Overseas unit sales decreased by 24,000 units (5.8%) year on year to 400,000 units. Combined domestic and overseas unit sales decreased by 20,000 units (4.2%) year on year to 450,000 units.

Revenue increased by 45.6 billion yen (2.1%) year on year to 2,209.0 billion yen due to profit contribution from foreign exchange fluctuation and price revision, despite rise in sales incentives and decreased unit sales. Segment profit increased by 37.9 billion yen (20.6%) year on year to 221.6 billion yen also due to the above factors.

#### (ii) Aerospace Division

Revenue increased by 7.1 billion yen (14.9%) year on year to 54.5 billion yen as sales increased in all of defense, commercial, and helicopter businesses. Segment loss came to 2.6 billion yen, representing a profit decline of 1.5 billion yen from the same period a year earlier.

#### (iii) Other Businesses

Revenue was 2.6 billion yen, about the same as previous period. Segment profit decreased by 0.2 billion yen (6.6%) year on year to 2.8 billion yen.

#### (2) Explanation about financial position

#### (i) Assets

Total assets at the end of September 2024 stood at 4,797.1 billion yen, a decreased of 17.0 billion yen compared to the end of the previous fiscal year. The key factors include: 1) a decrease of 75.2 billion yen in cash and cash equivalents due to payment of corporate taxes and dividends; 2) a decrease of 56.9 billion yen in other financial assets (non-current assets) mainly due to fluctuations in fair values of securities; and 3) an increase of 56.3 billion yen in property, plant and equipment due to capital investment and the like.

## (ii) Liabilities

Total liabilities increased by 12.0 billion yen from the end of the previous fiscal year to 2,260.8 billion yen. The key factors include: 1) an increase of 35.8 billion yen in trade and other payables due to an increase in accounts payable-trade; 2) an increase of 30.9 billion yen in other current liabilities due to an increase in deposits received and the like; and 3) a decrease of 39.9 billion yen in income taxes payable.

## (iii) Equity

Total equity decreased by 29.1 billion yen from the end of the previous fiscal year to 2,536.3 billion yen. The key factors include: 1) a decrease of 88.8 billion yen in other components of equity due to a decline in foreign currency translation adjustments; 2) an increase of 59.7 billion yen in treasury stock due to purchase of treasury shares; and 3) an increase of 119.4 billion yen in retained earnings resulting from posting of profit for the period and payment of dividends.

## (3) Explanation about cash flows

Cash and cash equivalents at the end of September 2024 totaled 972.8 billion yen.

## (i) Net cash provided by operating activities

Net cash provided by operating activities increased by 237.0 billion yen (same period a year earlier: an increase of 267.4 billion yen). The key factors include: 1) 221.0 billion yen in profit before tax; 2) 112.1 billion yen in depreciation and amortization; and 3) 108.9 billion yen in income taxes paid.

## (ii) Net cash provided by (used in) investing activities

Net cash provided by (used in) investment activities decreased by 155.9 billion yen (same period a year earlier: a decrease of 319.1 billion yen). The key factors include: 1) expenditures totaling 80.9 billion yen as a result of purchase of property, plant and equipment (net amount of proceeds from sale); 2) 42.4 billion yen in purchase of intangible assets and expenditure on internally generated intangible assets; and 3) expenditures totaling 13.3 billion yen as a result of purchase of securities (net amount of proceeds from sale).

# (iii) Net cash provided by (used in) financing activities

Net cash provided by (used in) financing activities declined by 125.7 billion yen (same period a year earlier: a decrease of 84.0 billion yen). The key factors include: 1) 60.0 billion yen in payments for purchase of treasury stock and 2) 43.6 billion yen in dividends paid to owners of the parent.

No revisions have been made to the consolidated financial forecast for the current fiscal year, which was announced on May 13, 2024.

## Subaru Corporation Announces Consolidated Financial Results for the First Half of FYE 2025

Tokyo, November 1, 2024 – Subaru Corporation today announced its consolidated financial results for the first half of the fiscal year ending March 31, 2025.

## Results for April-September 2024: Consolidated Revenue

While overseas production showed steady growth, increasing 2.5% to 177,000 units, domestic production fell 7.1% to 298,000 units due to factors including production adjustments at the beginning of the fiscal year. As a result, global production decreased 3.7% to 475,000 units.

In terms of consolidated unit sales, Japan showed strong performance, increasing 10.6%, driven primarily by sales of passenger vehicles, including the Levorg series with the Layback.

In the key U.S. market, retail sales posted the twenty-sixth consecutive month of increases through September 2024; however, due to the aforementioned production adjustment impacts, overseas consolidated sales decreased 5.8%. As a result, global consolidated unit sales fell 4.2% to 450,000 units.

Consolidated revenue increased by 2.4% to 2,266.2 billion yen, as factors such as favorable exchange rates and price revisions more than offset higher sales incentives caused by a competitive environment in overseas market and lower sales volume.

## Results for April-September 2024: Consolidated Profit and Loss

Due to the same factors impacting consolidated revenue, operating profit increased 19.5% to 222.0 billion yen, profit before tax decreased 2.4% to 221.0 billion yen, and profit for the period attributable to owners of parent increased 8.0% to 163.0 billion yen.

## Forecast for FYE 2025

Based on recent sales trends and inventory levels in overseas markets, the Company is revising its initial production forecast announced on May 13, 2024, downward by 10,000 units to 950,000 units. Similarly, the consolidated unit sales forecast has been reduced by 30,000 units to 950,000 units.

On the other hand, the revenue and profit forecasts for the full year remain unchanged from the initial announcement\*, incorporating factors such as controlling the increasing trend of sales incentives to industry-low levels and the effect of yen depreciation, with consolidated revenue expected to be 4,720 billion yen and operating profit 400 billion yen.

The latest forecasts for FYE 2025 are based on exchange rate assumptions of 149 yen to the U.S. dollar and 162 yen to the euro.
