Tokyo, November 30, 2012 - Fuji Heavy Industries Ltd. (FHI), the maker of Subaru automobiles, today announced that its “Subaru BRZ” sports coupe born in a joint development project with Toyota Motor Corporation (TMC) has received the 2012-2013 Car of the Year Japan “Special Award”.*

Developed with its product concept “Pure Handling Delight - the driving experience taken to a new level”, the Subaru BRZ is a front-engine, rear-wheel drive sports coupe offering sheer driving pleasure with excellent handling, which is enabled by the ultra-low center-of-gravity packaging with the Subaru Boxer engine mounted as low as possible.

The optimal combination of Subaru’s horizontally-opposed Boxer engine and Toyota’s “4-DS” direct injection technology highlights the successful collaboration realized in the TMC-FHI alliance.
