

## Subaru earns three 2022 IIHS *TOP SAFETY PICK*+ Awards (Applies to US models only)

- The 2023 Outback, 2023 Legacy, and the 2022 WRX received a 2022 TOP SAFETY PICK+
- Legacy earned an IIHS TOP SAFETY PICK award for 17 consecutive years
- Outback is an IIHS TOP SAFETY PICK for 14 consecutive years
- All three vehicles achieved a 'Superior' rating in front crash prevention (when equipped with EyeSight®)

Tokyo, November 9, 2022 – Subaru Corporation announced that the 2023 Outback, 2023 Legacy, and the 2022 WRX were named a 2022 *TOP SAFETY PICK*+ by the Insurance Institute for Highway Safety (IIHS). For 2022, 9 Subaru models which are currently available in the US, have received IIHS *TOP SAFETY PICK* awards.

To earn a 2022 *TOP SAFETY PICK* or *TOP SAFETY PICK*+ award, vehicles must receive 'Good' ratings in each of IIHS's six crashworthiness evaluations; 'Good' or 'Acceptable' headlight ratings, and available front crash prevention that achieves "Advanced" or "Superior" ratings in both vehicle-to-vehicle and daytime vehicle-to-pedestrian evaluations. The 'Plus' is awarded to models that come exclusively with 'Good' or 'Acceptable' headlights.

Since 2013, Subaru has received a cumulative total of 66 *TOP SAFETY PICK*+ awards, which is more than any other brand.\*1\*2
