

## **Subaru WRX STI Scores Back-to-Back Class Win in the 47<sup>th</sup> Nürburgring 24-Hour Race**

Tokyo, June 24, 2019 – Subaru Corporation is pleased to announce that its motorsports subsidiary, Subaru Tecnica International (STI)<sup>\*1</sup>, took the SP3T class<sup>\*2</sup> win in the 47th Nürburgring 24-Hour Race held in Germany from June 20 to 23, with the “Subaru WRX STI NBR Challenge 2019”, a racing car developed based on a WRX STI mass-production model.

This is the second consecutive class win and its sixth title in the Nürburgring 24-Hour Race for Subaru WRX STI. The victory is a testament that the Subaru WRX STI is capable of fully exerting its AWD sports performance on circuits like Nürburgring, which is so-called one of the most challenging tracks in the world.
